







- I. <u>Prewriting practice</u>: Trace the lines. If you don't laminate the pages, kids can color the black and white pages.
- 2. <u>Cover me</u>: Use pom poms, buttons, or bingo chips to cover the circles on each picture.
- 3. <u>Pom pom mat</u>: Use pom poms to build the picture. Count the pom poms used and write the number on the line.
- 4. <u>Geoboard</u>: Use rubber bands to build the picture on a geoboard. Count the colored rubber bands used, and write the number on the lines.
- 5. <u>Snap cubes</u>: Use snap cubes to build the picture. Count the colored blocks, and write the number on the lines.

- 9. Tracing lines: Trace the lines from left to right.



























